Amendments to the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions for Winston Trails Foundation, Inc. ("Declaration"). The original Declaration is recorded in Official Records Book 7820, Page 281, of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

[Added language is underlined and deleted language is struck through.]

Item #1: Article VIII, Section 9 of the Declaration shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 9. <u>Visibility at Intersections</u>. No obstruction to visibility at street intersections or Common Area intersections shall be permitted; <u>provided the Foundation shall not be liable in any manner to any person or entity, including Owners and Members' Permittees, for any damages, injuries or deaths arising from any violation of this Section. No motor vehicles shall be parked on Common Areas or public or private streets.</u>

Item #2: Article VIII, Section 10 of the Declaration shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Commercial Trucks, Trailers, Campers and Boats; Remedy of Towing. Restrictions, if any, on commercial trucks, trailers, campers and boats (particularly as to the parking or storage thereof) shall be imposed and enforced by the applicable Neighborhood Associations; provided, however, that no commercial trucks, trailers, campers or boats shall be parked or stored within the Common Areas if the Foundation prohibits such parking or storage by regulation or otherwise.

Subject to applicable laws and ordinances, any vehicle parked in violation of these or other restrictions contained herein or in the rules and regulations now or hereafter adopted may be towed by the Foundation at the sole expense of the owner of such vehicle if such vehicle remains in violation for a period of 24 hours from the time a notice of violation is placed on the vehicle. The Foundation shall not be liable to the owner of such vehicle for trespass, conversion or otherwise, nor guilty of any criminal act, by reason of such towing and once the notice is posted, neither its removal, nor failure of the owner to receive it for any other reason, shall be grounds for relief of any kind. For purposes of this paragraph, "vehicle" shall also mean campers, mobile homes and trailers. An affidavit of the person posting the aforesaid notice stating that it was properly posted shall be conclusive evidence of proper-posting. The Foundation will comply with all state and local ordinances in the implementation and enforcement a policy regarding towing of any vehicle parked in violation of these or other restrictions contained in the rules and regulations now or hereafter adopted by the Foundation.
