# WINSTON TRAILS EXTERIOR STANDARDS

### **General Requirements**

- **ARB Application:** An ARB (Architectural Review Board) application must be submitted for review and approval for all exterior changes to the house. Work cannot begin until approval is received.
- **Goal:** Ensure that all aspects of the home, including the roof, driveway, and paint colors, coordinate appropriately.
- **Timing:** It is understood that changes to the roof, house paint, and driveway may not occur simultaneously for most homeowners.
- **Neighborhood Villages:** Some neighborhood villages may have more restrictive guidelines. Please check these guidelines before submitting your application.
- **Color Palettes:** Available on the Winston Trails HOA website (winstontrailshoa.com) and in the office.

### **Paint Color Schemes**

- Total of 38 color schemes.
- Organized Color Schemes:
  - Whites
  - Creams
  - o Tans
  - Grays
  - Greens
- White on White: Permitted.
- Maximum Colors: A maximum of three (3) colors is permitted for each house.

## **Components of the House**

- 1. **Body:** 
  - The body includes all the exterior walls of the home.
  - Body colors must be selected from the approved schemes.
- 2. **Trim:** 
  - Defined as all non-body elements, such as window frames and door frames, etc.
  - Each scheme includes two (2) trim colors to choose from. The color listed or Extra White.
- 3. Accent:
  - Can be used on shutters, front doors, pedestrian doors, and garage doors.
  - Each scheme offers 1- 3 accent colors to choose from.

#### 4. Garage Door:

- May be painted the same color as the body, trim, or coordinating accent color.
- Faux wood painting is permitted; may be used on either or both the garage and front door.

#### 5. Driveways:

- $\circ$   $\,$  May be stained or coated from the approved color list.
- Geometric patterns and shapes are permitted but must all be in the same color scheme and coordinate with the house.

#### 6. **Roofs:**

- Grouped into three schemes: Terracotta, Browns, Whites and Grays.
- The roof must coordinate with the body and trim of the house.
- If installing a new roof and not painting the house immediately, the roof color must still coordinate with the existing colors.
- If installing a new roof and then painting, homeowners must state the colors they will be using on the ARB application.
